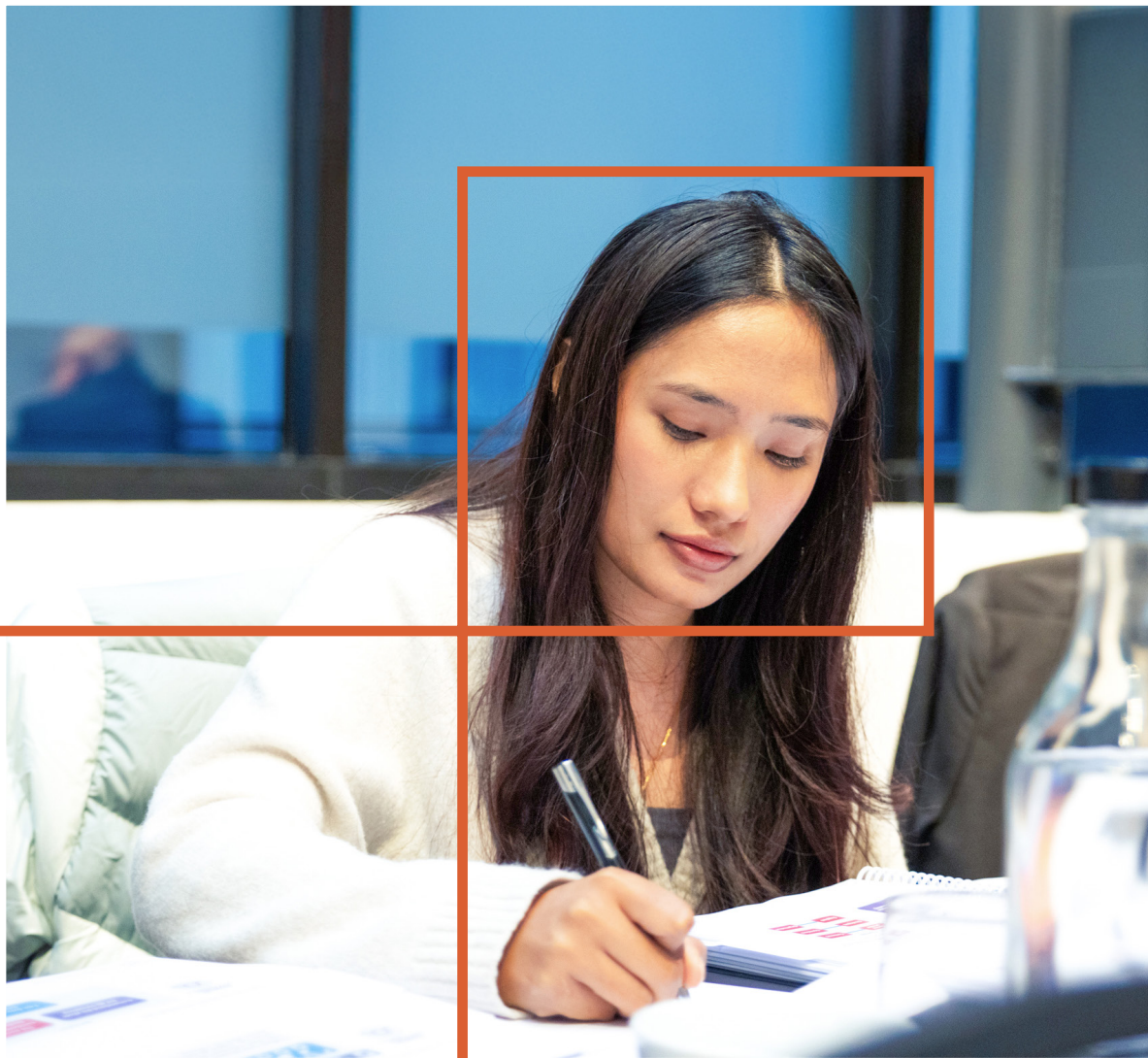

AgilePM® (version 3) Foundation & Practitioner

4 Days

Developed by APMG in association with the Agile Business Consortium, this certification course is aimed at anyone in a project environment who is looking for a leaner, structured approach that enables a faster response to change and is conducive to rapid implementation of high priority initiatives.

This latest version includes the additional 90 minute online interactive group simulation activity which provides students with experiential learning and hands-on approach to mastering agile methodologies.

PRINCE2 Program Management® (MSP Version 5) Foundation and Practitioner

5 Days

MSP fully-accredited course comprising Foundation (three day) and Practitioner Prep (two day) modules. It explores the MSP project management approach, where large complex change is broken down into manageable, inter-related projects, helping organisations to avoid pitfalls and achieve their transformational goals. The course is available as a five day combined Foundation/Practitioner course or as a three day Foundation module on its own.

PRINCE2 Portfolio Management® (MOP) Foundation and Practitioner

4 Days

Many organisations focus on the performance of individual projects, or at best on the performance of individual programmes and projects, rather than on the performance of the sum-total of all their change initiatives ie, the portfolio. This makes it difficult to properly evaluate the cumulative effect that change initiatives will have on the organisation and to coordinate the implementation of change so as to safeguard the integrity of business operations.

To address this, the Office of Government Commerce (OGC) has recently published the MoP Guide (Management of Portfolios) to accompany the already existing guidance for Programme Management (MSP®) and Project Management (PRINCE2®).

PRINCE2 Project Programme, Portfolio Office Management® (P3O) Foundation and Practitioner

4 Days

The P3O model was developed by the OGC (UK Office of Government Commerce) and is from the same stable as PRINCE2® and MSP®.

It provides the structure, governance, functions and services required for defining a balanced portfolio of change and ensuring consistent delivery of programmes and projects across an organisation or department. It could successfully take many forms, all of which are explored with the P3O guidance – from a single all-encompassing physical office to a complex model made up of a permanent Portfolio Office supported by permanent hubs and temporary Programme/Project Offices.
